## 2025 YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP SINGLES SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Check In: Check-in time for the squad is 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time.
- 2. All bowlers are expected to wear neat and appropriate attire (shorts of appropriate length and T-shirts are allowed). The tournament director reserves the right to ask any bowler to change out of inappropriate attire or be disqualified.
- 3. Eligibility: All entrants must be currently certified through USBC and bowling as a regular member of a Youth League in a center that is within the CAUSBCA boundaries (Bowlero Cary/Raleigh, Buffaloe Cary/Erwin/North/South, Rainbow Lanes and Stars & Strikes).
- 4. Bowlers will use their highest 2024-2025 USBC certified average with 21 games or more (including summer). Sport averages will only be used (after adjustment) if the bowler does not have a house-shot average. Bowlers without a 2024-25 USBC average will use November 14, 2025 average of 12 games or more. Bowlers without either of these may enter scratch (230 average). Anyone not having a Bowl.com average must furnish proof of average by providing a league standing sheet with entry form.
- 5. Handicap: Handicap per game will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and a scratch basis of 230.
- 6. Entry Fee: The cost of the tournament is \$25.00 and will be divided as follows: \$12.00 lineage, \$12.00 scholarship, and \$1.00 expenses. There is an Optional Scratch Event for \$5.00. Scholarships will be managed through SMART- Account # 8854 smart@bowl.com or call 800.514.2695.
- 7. Tardy Rule: Any bowler arriving late will begin play with score to begin counting in the frame bowled. Each frame missed will receive a zero.
- 8. Entry Closing Date: Completed entry forms and appropriate fees **must be postmarked no later than November 25, 2025**. No refunds will be given after the entry closing date. Walk-ins will be allowed based on lane availability for an extra \$5.
- 9. Squad time: There will be one (1) squad on Sunday, December 7, 2025 at 10:00am. Check-in will begin at 9:30am.
- 10. Format: Each participant will bowl three (3) games. Scores including handicap will determine position standings. The Optional scratch event will use the same scores as the handicap event.
- 11. Capital Area USBC Association will donate \$1000 (\$800 for handicap/\$200 for scratch) to the scholarship payout of the tournament. This amount is allocated based upon the percentage of entries in each division (for handicap and scratch). A bowler may win scholarship money in both Handicap and the Optional Scratch events.
- 12. Scholarship money collected will be kept within the division of the participant.
- 13. Scholarship awards will be based upon a 1:7 ratio (or major fraction thereof) in each division. The Scratch division is Optional and will use a payout option of 1:7 (or major fraction thereof)
- 14. If a bowler does not show up, the prize fund money paid by that bowler will stay within that division.
- 15. This is a USBC certified tournament. All USBC rules will apply.
- 16. The decision of the tournament director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- 17. Confirmations will not be mailed, but a list of participants will be posted on our website by December 3, 2025.

Don't forget to send in standing sheets with averages as of November 14, 2025.
