CITY CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. This tournament is certified through the United States Bowling Congress. Rules not covered on this form are governed by USBC rules and regulations. Submittal of entry form confirms that the bowlers have read and understand the rules of the tournament.
2. All sanctioned bowlers of the Capital Area USBC Association (CAUSBCA) may enter this tournament, provided they have an average of 21 or more games bowled in any USBC-sanctioned league within the jurisdiction of CAUSBCA. Bowlers may submit multiple entries for this tournament. Bowlers must submit a separate entry form each time entering the tournament.
3. There are four divisions within this tournament: Male Bowler, Senior Male Bowler, Female Bowler and Senior Female bowler. To be eligible for the Senior Divisions, the bowler must have reached their 50th birthday by August 1, 2026. Bowlers must indicate the division on the entry form for which they are entering. **Bowlers may enter both regular and senior divisions (if age appropriate) but must submit a separate entry form for each division and bowl a separate squad.**
4. Entrants will bowl a series of three (3) games on one pair of lanes. Highest pinfall plus handicap will determine the winner of each division.
5. Bowlers will use their highest 2025-2026 USBC certified average with 21 games or more. Sport averages will only be used (after adjustment) if the bowler does not have a house-shot average.
 - a. A bowler without a 2025-2026 certified average will use their highest USBC certified current average of at least 21 games as of October 3, 2026. League standing sheet must be provided with entry form or at the tournament. Tournament Director has the right to re-rate based on past performances in Association tournaments.
 - b. A bowler who does not qualify under the above conditions will enter with a 230 average.
 - c. It is each bowler's responsibility to determine that the submitted average is correct. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average thereby resulting in more handicap or different position standings. If the submitted average is higher, then the higher average will be used.
 - d. Average corrections can be made until the end of the first game of the squad.
 - e. The 10 or more pins increase in average provision of USBC Rule 319a-2 will not apply for this tournament.
6. USBC rule 319c reporting winnings in the last 12 months will not apply for this tournament.
7. The entry fee for this tournament is \$35.00 per person, per entry, per division. An optional scratch event is available for \$5.00.
8. The prize payout will be 100% of the prize fund and the payout is 1 out of every 8 entries (or major fraction thereof) for handicap. The scratch division is optional, and payout is 1 out of every 8 entries (or major fraction thereof). A bowler may only cash once per division. In cases of ties for placements, money for the placements will be added together and split equally.
9. Handicap is 90% of 230.
10. Entries will be scheduled for the squad choice in order of receipt by mail as evidenced by postmark. The tournament may cancel a shift when deemed in the best interest of the bowlers. Information will be posted on our website at www.raleighbowls.com and Facebook page "Raleighbowls" by October 13, 2026.
11. All entrants will report to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes before their scheduled bowling time.
12. Tele-scores are the official score sheet. Bowlers are responsible for checking their own scores while bowling and turning in their signed recap form to the tournament director.
13. Any protests must be filed within 72 hours of tournament competition. If there is a protest, prize funds will be held until the protest is resolved.
14. Entrants will NOT receive a refund after entry forms and fees are received and processed.
15. Make all checks/money orders payable to Capital Area USBC Association. A \$30.00 fee will be charged for returned checks. Entries with returned checks shall lose their place in the tournament schedule and will not be rescheduled until acceptable payment is made. Please **DO NOT SEND CASH.**
16. Tournament prize money will not be awarded until the winners' averages are verified and will be mailed within 30 days from the end of the tournament, providing there are no protests. Tournament checks will be voided after 90 days from the date on the check. Final standings will be posted on our website at www.raleighbowls.com.
17. The lane condition for the tournament will be a modified house pattern.
18. Entries must be postmarked by October 2, 2026. Bowlers may also enter this tournament on site for an additional \$5 fee (Cash or Cash App ONLY) but must arrive an hour earlier than the beginning of the shift. On-site registration is NOT GUARANTEED and subject to lane availability. Re-entries will be allowed on-site (Cash or Cash App ONLY) at the rate of the original fee subject to lane availability.
19. CAUSBCA will add \$500 based on 30 entries to the Handicap Prize Fund to be split across the divisions based on the percentage of entries. For every additional 15 entries an additional \$100 will be added to the Prize Fund up to a maximum of \$1,500.
20. The tournament director will make the final decisions on protests and questions not covered by these rules or the rules of the USBC.
